

Book Title: <u>Daddy Hugs</u> Author and Illustrator: Nancy Tafuri



Core words	different, like, turn, me, good, same
C - Completion	A core word, sentence, or phrase that can be repeated in this book is: "I love/like it" "Just daddy and me hugs" Turn page (Model why questions who/where)
R - Recall	Details to consider asking the child to recall: What animals are in the story? (offer picture choices) Who did the animals give a hug to (dad)
O - Open Ended	Questions to ask that have no right or wrong answer: Do you like the story? Who do you like to get hugs from? What kind of hug do you like the best?
W - WH Questions	Who, what, where, when, why questions: Where do you go to sleep? Where is the little? Did any animals give the <u>same</u> type of hug?
D - Distance	Questions that bridge to the child's life or other learning: Who might you give a hug to? Why might you give someone a hug?
