

Book Title: **Daddy Hugs**

Core words	finish, more, same, different, turn, I, love/like, feel, good, wet
C - Completion	A core word, sentence, or phrase that can be repeated in this book is: I love Juse Daddy and (me).
R - Recall	Details to consider asking the child to recall: What kind of hug does beaver like? What animals were in the story?
O - Open Ended	Questions to ask that have no right or wrong answer: What kind of hug do you think is best? Who can give hugs? How do hugs make you feel?
W - WH Questions	Who, what, where, when, why questions: Who gave all the hugs? What kind of hug did the turtle (other animals) like?
D - Distance	Questions that bridge to the child's life or other learning: Who might you give a hug to? Why might you hug someone? Do you think all people or animals give the same types of hugs?

- **C** Comment
- **A** Ask a question type from above
- **R** Respond to the question adding more information
