Core words	out, it, stop, up, go, finished, open, turn
C - Completion	A core word, sentence, or phrase that can be repeated in this book is: "Goodnight, goodnight"
R - Recall	Details to consider asking the child to recall: What did he say at the end of the day?
O - Open Ended	Questions to ask that have no right or wrong answer: Which truck was your favorite? What do you think they were building?
W - WH Questions	Who, what, where, when, why questions: When did they finish their work? Where were the vehicles? What color was (vehicle)?
D - Distance	Questions that bridge to the child's life or other learning: Where you have seen (vehicle)? When you get tired, where do you go to sleep?
