Core words	see, look, on, go, in, play
C - Completion	A core word, sentence, or phrase that can be repeated in this book is: "I see"
R - Recall	Details to consider asking the child to recall: What color are the trees? What animals, costumes or food did you see? (Could be three separate questions)
O - Open Ended	Questions to ask that have no right or wrong answer: What do you want to be for Halloween? What do you like to eat for Thanksgiving?
W - WH Questions	Who, what, where, when, why questions Who came to eat Thanksgiving dinner? When do we wear costumes?
D - Distance	Questions that bridge to the child's life or other learning: What did your family eat for Thanksgiving? Did you help make your costume (or Thanksgiving dinner)?

**A** - Ask a question type from above

**R** - Respond to the question adding more information



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
