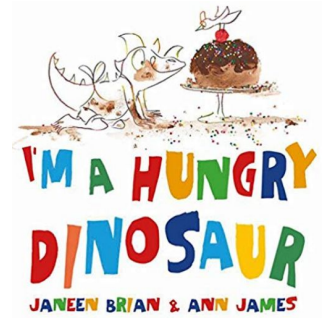

Book Title: **I'm a Hungry Dinosaur**  
 Authors: Janeen Brian and Ann James



Core words	make, can, in, I, it, on, look, more, like
C - Completion	A core word, sentence, or phrase that can be repeated in this book is: <b>“I’m a hungry dinosaur”</b> Could change some words to be put/pat/tip
R - Recall	Details to consider asking the child to recall: <b>What did the dinosaur do with his cake? (watched it, mixed it, frosted it, sprinkled it, smelled it)</b>
O - Open Ended	Questions to ask that have no right or wrong answer: <b>How did the dinosaur feel about his cake?</b>
W - WH Questions	Who, what, where, when, why questions: <b>Who make a cake?</b> <b>Where did he bake his cake?</b> <b>Why do you think he made a cake?</b>
D - Distance	Questions that bridge to the child’s life or other learning: <b>What desserts do you like?</b> <b>When do we usually eat cake?</b>

**Drive the Shared Reading Car:**

- C** - Comment
- A** - Ask a question type from above
- R** - Respond to the question adding more information
