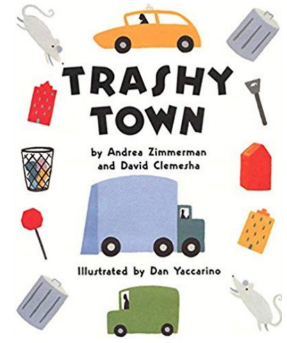

Book Title: **Trashy Town**

Core words	in, on, put, up, go, stop
C - Completion	A core word, sentence, or phrase that can be repeated in this book is: <b>Dump it IN</b> <b>STOP!</b> <b>PUT IT IN</b>
R - Recall	Details to consider asking the child to recall: <b>What animals are in every picture?</b> <b>How does Mr. Gilly help?</b>
O - Open Ended	Questions to ask that have no right or wrong answer: <b>Would you like to pick up garbage?</b> <b>How does trash smell?</b>
W - WH Questions	Who, what, where, when, why questions: <b>Who is Mr. Gilly?</b> <b>What does he pick up?</b>
D - Distance	Questions that bridge to the child's life or other learning: <b>Have you met your garbage man?</b> <b>Where does our trash go?</b>

**Drive the Shared Reading Car:**

- C** - Comment
- A** - Ask a question type from above
- R** - Respond to the question adding more information
