

Book Title: Where, Oh Where is Baby Bear?

Core words	where, when, in, go, look, here, I, up, on
C - Completion	A core word, sentence, or phrase that can be repeated in this book is: Where Oh Where is baby bear? Here I am, Mama
R - Recall	Details to consider asking the child to recall: What were some of his hiding spaces? Do you see him before he tells her?
O - Open Ended	Questions to ask that have no right or wrong answer: Do you ever hide like baby bear? What are some of your favorite places to hide?
W - WH Questions	Who, what, where, when, why questions: Where was baby bear hiding? Who was looking for baby bear? What other animals were in the story (or on each page)?
D - Distance	Questions that bridge to the child's life or other learning: Do you like to play hide and seek? Have you ever seen a bear before? (Zoo? Real life? TV?)

- **C** Comment
- A Ask a question type from above
- **R** Respond to the question adding more information
